Alpha of Ohio would like to congratulate you on your induction into the largest honor society of its kind in the world. As a new member, your journey with Phi Theta Kappa is just beginning. Our four Hallmarks of the society, Scholarship, Leadership, Service, and Fellowship, offers you a wide range of opportunity for personal growth and development.

In addition, there are many scholarship opportunities available to you. These obtainable scholarships can help with tuition during your tenure as a community college student and as a transfer student to a four-year institution. Annually, there is more than \$36 million available for transfer scholarships to more than 600 colleges nationwide.

The Ohio Region also provides scholarship opportunities to its members and those are paid for through donations and fundraisers. One of our fundraisers is the sale of the Ohio Specialty License Plate dedicated to Phi Theta Kappa. With the sale of each set of plates, the Ohio Region receives \$25 toward scholarships for Ohio Region Phi Theta Kappa students.

The cost is an additional \$35 for each set of plates and anyone may buy them. Parents, aunts and uncles, grandparents, and friends may purchase plates at any Ohio BMV agency. No one need be a member to support the society's scholarship fund. Of course, displaying Phi Theta Kappa license plates on your vehicle expresses your membership and brings awareness to the society. Can't afford plates while you are a student? Ask for a set as a holiday gift, birthday, or graduation. What parent could refuse?
